Aim & Scope of NHIJMR

Publishing ethics

All the articles received by the journal will be first reviewed by the chief-editor and a review committee for their appropriateness and completeness in terms of the requirement of the journal. Once the papers are cleared by the committee they will go for final publication in the journal. This is keeping in with the standards stipulated by any international refereed journal.

Researchers should conduct their research from research proposal to publication in line with best practices and codes of conduct of relevant professional bodies. Editor’s Responsibilities:

- Clearly communicating all other editorial policies and standards
- The editor should assess manuscripts for their quality and intellectual content, free from any bias. The editor shall evaluate manuscripts objectively based on their academic merit free of any commercial or self-interest.
- The editor shall not disclose any information on submitted manuscripts before publication of the manuscripts.
- If at any stage the publisher suspects any kind of misconduct in the research, it should be investigated promptly; and if any act of misconduct is observed in the peer review, it should be resolved with diligence.

Reviewer’s Responsibilities:

- Providing clear, constructive and unbiased feedback in an appropriate manner on the value of the work submitted by the authors. Maintain the documented basis for the reviewer’s opinion
- Signifying whether the research paper is clear, concise, and relevant with the theme of the journal; assessing the work in terms of its composition, scientific accuracy, originality, and interest to the journal’s readers
- Offer an unbiased comments or criticism, which is in best interest of the journal.

- Maintaining the confidentiality of the review process and not disclosing any information from the reviewed paper

Author's Responsibility

- All the work reported in the manuscripts must be an original piece of work and should be free from any kind of plagiarism
- The work should not have been published elsewhere or submitted to any other journal at the same time.
