Orientation on Career Opportunities by HRD Department

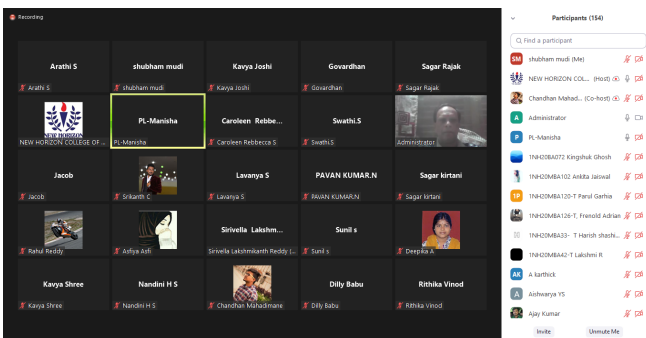
