

DATA VISUALIZATION AND INFOGRAPHICS IN PROJECT MANAGEMENT AND REPORTING



INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO UNIBIC FACTORY

On the 18th of APR 2022, Department of Management Studies conducted an "INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO UNIBIC FACTORY". This visit was for the awareness of the students on the production process of the company. The Industrial visit started at 9:30AM and travelling was for two hours. Once we reached the factory, a person who was in charge of the production department welcomed us to the UNIBIC cookies factory. Firstly they provided us with disposable bouffant cap for protection purpose, and they took us to the production site and explained us how the product actually goes on. There are different phases taken place in the process of production like first phase is mixing the raw materials using the hopper, the next phase is to shape the basic materials and then they'll bake the product by sending them into the oven at a particular temperatures from 150 degrees to 300 degree centigrade in just 8 minutes. After baking, these products will be sent into the cooler wherein it gives crispy and crunch to the cookies. And the final phase is packaging, the size of package varies based on quantity required like from 20 grams to 200 grams and the main label will be pre-printed except the price, date of manufacture, date of expiry, batch number. Then automatic taping machines will pack the bulky products together. Everything in the process was systematic with very less idle time and lots of skilled workers are present at the packaging area showcasing their talents. At the end of the session they gave us good send off and complimentary biscuit packets. There was also a factory outlet where the biscuits were provided with a very good discount. Finally we reported back to college. On behalf of the students of the department of management studies, we would like to express our gratitude towards Dr.Sheelan Misra ma'am and the entire faculty for providing us with this wonderful opportunity and a new learning experience to explore in the industries.
