

Two video activity on time management was also conducted for the students ,MBA-I sem students actively participated .Time management matrix was also discussed in brief.




ORIENTATION TALK ON "GOAL SETTING FOR MANAGERS"

Department of Management organized a guest lecture as part of the PG Orientation Program for the first-year MBA students. The session was held in the Falconry Hall and was attended by students from all three sections. We had the privilege of hosting Dr. Dunstan Rajkumar, Professor from the Department of Commerce, Vellore Institute of Technology, Vellore, Bangalore. Dr. Rajkumar delivered an engaging lecture focusing on key topics relevant to budding managers: Goal Setting for Managers, SMART Goals, Creating a Positive Mindset, and Cultivating a Growth Mindset.



Key Insights from the Lecture

Goal Setting for Managers

Effective goal setting is pivotal for managerial success. Dr. Rajkumar emphasized the importance of defining clear and SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, Time-bound) objectives. highlighted the need to align goals with organizational priorities and engage teams in the goal-setting process to ensure understanding and commitment. Breaking down larger objectives into smaller tasks with milestones, regular progress and monitoring, constructive feedback were presented as vital strategies. Additionally, he stressed the importance of flexibility, resource allocation, and celebrating achievements to maintain motivation and foster a positive organizational culture.

Creating a Positive Mindset

Dr. Rajkumar underscored the role of a positive mindset in personal and professional effectiveness. A positive outlook nurtures resilience, creativity, and proactive problemsolving, enabling individuals to focus on solutions rather than challenges. He emphasized practices such gratitude, as mindfulness, and affirmations to reduce stress and enhance mental well-being. A positive mindset was highlighted as a tool for fostering collaboration, boosting confidence, and driving individuals toward achieving their goals and leading fulfilling lives.

Embracing a Growth Mindset

The lecture also covered the concept of a growth mindset—the belief that abilities and intelligence can be developed through effort, learning, and perseverance. Dr. Rajkumar encouraged students to view challenges as growth opportunities and failures as lessons. He highlighted the significance of seeking feedback, persisting through difficulties, and focusing on progress rather than perfection. A growth mindset, he explained, fuels curiosity, innovation, and adaptability, empowering individuals to unlock their potential and achieve long-term success.
