	resource person. The workshop aimed to provide students with a practical understanding of how
	the stock market functions, covering both basic and advanced concepts related to investing and
	trading. A total of 151 students participated in the workshop, which was conducted in two batches
	to ensure better interaction and engagement.

During the session, students were introduced to the fundamentals of the stock market, including how it operates and its significance in the financial system. The resource person explained fundamental analysis, helping students learn how to evaluate companies based on their financial statements and performance indicators. He also covered technical analysis, demonstrating how to read and interpret various charts such as candlesticks, bars, and line charts, which are essential tools for traders.

One of the key takeaways from the workshop was understanding how psychology impacts investing and trading decisions, emphasizing the importance of managing emotions and avoiding common behavioral biases. Mr. Kishore also explained practical strategies on when to enter and exit the market, giving students useful insights into timing and risk management. The sessions were interactive, with students participating in discussions and Q & A sessions that enhanced their grasp of the subject.

Overall, the workshop was a great success. It significantly improved students' awareness of financial markets, boosted their confidence in understanding investment-related concepts, and ignited a keen interest in financial literacy.
